2023 CLASS XLIII PROGRAM & HOW TO APPLY

The Leadership Daytona program is designed to provide employers and their selected team members with the opportunity to participate in a distinctive program which works to solidify their leadership position and impact within our region. Participants find the program elements work to cultivate a learning mindset and the willingness to "let go of what you know" while developing yourself as a new leader that represents your organization with leadership intelligence. Important to employer's, these team members often become empowered with a broad-based knowledge of our community and are able to participate in significant projects fully equipped with behaviors that display leadership effectiveness as a representative of your organization. Through participation in the Leadership Daytona program class members build life-long networks which continue to cooperatively solidify their company's leadership position and impact, while also personally having pride in their role in future leadership decision making.

Program elements include weekly visitations to a variety of significant business, government, charitable and educational facilities while listening and learning from subject matter experts on specific topics that lend to a thriving community and economy over the 11-week course of the program.

As an actual test of servant leadership, class members will be faced with solving a specially designed Daytona Regional Chamber Chairmans Challenge. It will take grit, collaboration with multiple personalities, and an eager desire to achieve while learning to accomplish purposeful goals.

Classes are scheduled to take place weekly with the Opening Session on Thursday, July 20th, 2023, and SIMSOC on Friday, July 28th, 2023, followed by weekly classes through to Graduation on Friday, October 6, 2023. These three specific dates listed also serve as Mandatory Attendance in order to graduate Leadership Daytona Class XLIII. Throughout the remaining schedule participants may miss one session with pre-approval for needs.
